

# Performance Solution Template 2019 – Request to members for Quotes Residential Apartment (Class 2, 3, & 4) Heated and Cold Water Systems Outside the DTS provisions of AS/NZS 3500.1 and AS/NZS 3500.4

Dear Members,

The HCAA are currently undertaking an investigation related to metered flow rated experienced in cold water systems in various types of buildings.

## This Approach to Market (ATM) is for the provision of:

A Performance Solution In accordance with NCC 2019 for the sizing of Residential Apartments, NCC Class 2, 3, & 4 Heated and Cold Water Piping Systems in line with the German DIN 1988(300) – 2012.

### **Approach to Market Details**

In anticipation of the results of HCAA's 2019 Class 2, 3 residential water demand study, we wish to prepare a performance solution **template** for use by all members free of charge. This template will be prepared in such a way that permits a member to modify the contents to make it specific to their individual project for submission to the relevant technical regulator.

By early to mid 2020, we believe the data collected will be sufficient to verify that the German DIN standard provides flow rates far closer to reality than those of the current Australian Standard and these results will be suitable for verification of the performance solution for these types of developments. The initial template will be NSW based with subsequent versions to include minor edits for other states.

٠	Approach, Systems and Management	15%
•	Total Qualitative	70%
•	Cost	30%

The submissions and presentations will need to provide the Evaluation Panel with a confirmation of the proponents understanding of the project objectives.
